COCHISE COUNTY – AT A GLANCE

GENERAL INFO: In southeastern Arizona, Cochise County is larger in land mass than the states of Rhode Island and Connecticut combined.

POPULATION: 130,220 residents

CLIMATE: Generally sunny and mild, Cochise County’s elevations climb to nearly 10,000 feet. This topography offers mild winters and summer temperatures cooler than those of low-lying deserts. Mountain ranges include the Dragoons, Mules, Whetstones, Chiricahuas, Huachucas, Pedrogosa, Peloncillo, Perilla, Dos Cabezas and Swisshelms. Average highs in the summer range in the 80s to 90s; low temperatures in winter are typically in the mid-30s.
